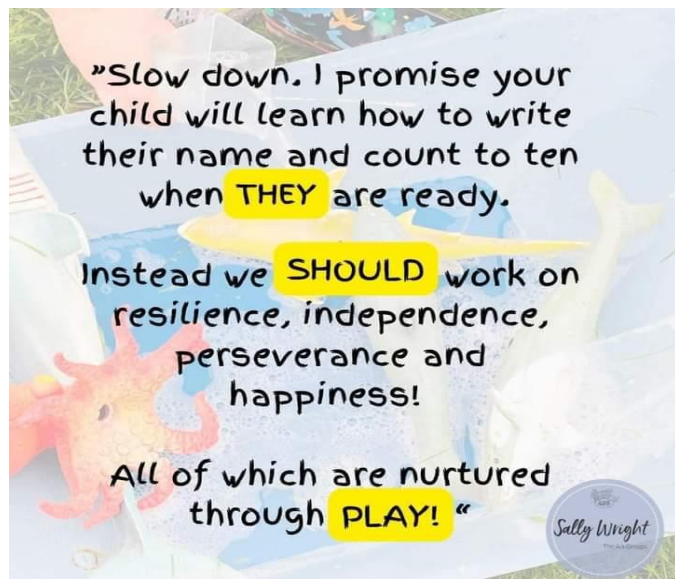


A VERY WARM WELCOME TO OUR NEWSLETTER
